Attempted Arson Suspect Arrested

The Kootenai County Sheriff's Department is investigating an Attempted Arson which occurred last night at a home on Estates Road in Athol, Idaho. The suspect, 30 year old Daniel F. Rose, allegedly threw a "Molotov cocktail" at his ex-girlfriend's home last night. Although there was a small fire on the grass, which was quickly extinguished, the home did not receive any damage and there were no injuries.

Rose could not be located last night, however, detectives discovered his location this morning at a home located on Meyer Road in Rathdrum, Idaho. Rose was not initially cooperative with law enforcement as he was also wanted on an active warrant for a battery charge which carries a \$5000 bond. Through negotiations, Rose complied with law enforcement requests to exit the house, where he was arrested without complication.



This incident began as a telephone harassment occurring last week where Rose allegedly made threats to harm his ex-girlfriend and escalated to the attempted arson last night.
