Media Release May 31, 2011

On May 31, 2011 at approx. 1515 hrs. the Kootenai County Sheriff's Dept. was advised that the US Marshall's Service was in pursuit of a motorcycle in the area of Ramsey and Wyoming in Hayden Idaho. The pursuit started in Coeur d'Alene in the area of Wilbur Ave. The pursuit ended on Lancaster and Hayden Lk. Rd. when the Suspect, William T. Tomblin, age 40 drove the motorcycle off the road and into the trees. Tomblin then took off into the woods on foot.

The Sheriff's dept. along with Idaho State Police set up a perimeter in the area to contain the suspect. A K-9 was dispatched to the area to assist. Prior to the K-9 being deployed the suspect was located and taken into custody by units on scene.

Tomblin was transported to the Spokane County Public Safety Building by the Joint Federal Task Force and book on a warrant.
