On July 03, 2011 at approximately 2245 hours, deputies from the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department along with Kootenai Fire and medical personnel responded to the Stateline Speedway at 1349 N. Beck Rd., west of Post Falls, Idaho, for a vehicle versus pedestrian collision.

After the fireworks display a large crowd was attempting to exit the parking lot of the Speedway and a brief argument began between motorists. During the argument, Jefferson A. Dauenhauer 38 years old from Spokane, WA struck Margret A. Burk 65 years old from Mead, WA, with his SUV causing Burk to fall and hit her head on the ground. Burk was transported to KMC with non-life threatening injuries.

Charges are pending against Dauenhauer. Alcohol is not suspected as a factor.
