Details: We used the information from the above stated tabs. The only person that had any portion of their time as indirect is the Sergeant. We calculated how much of his wage was for indirect and how much was for direct (Line 23). We also figured out the wages for the rest of the staff (C16:C18). This allowed us to determine the breakdown between direct and indirect wages for the department (Line 26 and 27). The County Support Costs came from the 2015 Kootenia County Indirect Cost Allocation Plan on page 9. Using the percentages from lines 26 and 27, we were able to break the "Indirect County Support Costs" into the direct and indirect Civil portions (Line 33 and 34). We then allocated the direct amount to each position (D15:D18). We then calculated the average wage and average hourly rate per position (E15:F18). Last we calculated Civil's Overhead rate.
